Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for directing second and third respondents to provide security guards for him.

It is pleaded that petitioner is a social worker and is running an organization namely Anti Corruption Social Organization.

In para 5 of the writ petition it has been averred that the petitioner has established offices in Delhi, Uttrakhand as also Shillong, State of Meghalaya apart from his office in Batala district Gurdaspur. It has been averred that the petitioner has received threats at the hands of anti social elements so as to eliminate him and as such, the prayer in the instant writ petition has been made.

Counsel has been heard at length.

The averments made in the petition are not corroborated by any material placed on record or details furnished in the writ petition itself. Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

No interference in the matter is warranted.

Petition is dismissed.
