ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 124, dated 07.05.2019, under Section 397, 392, 342, 412, 459, 120-B and 216 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Charkhi Dadri, District Charkhi Dadri.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is an outcome of a matrimonial dispute between the complainant and co-accused Sanju Devi, who is the wife of the complainant. The petitioner is alleged to have helped the co-accused Sanju Devi in robbing the cash and other articles lying in the house of the complainant. The petitioner is in custody for over 5 ½ months. He further contends that the co-accused Sanju Devi has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-37113-2019 on 09.09.2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jeet Singh states that charges are being framed before the trial Court today itself.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 5 ½ months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
