Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.105 dated 28.09.2017 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 427 IPC and Sections 25/27-54-59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal, earlier one was disposed of vide order dated 30.11.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was initially granted the concession of regular bail, however, he absented from the Court proceedings on 02.11.2018 and thereafter, he was declared a proclaimed offender on 15.05.2019. It is further submitted that on account of his employment, the petitioner had gone to Maharashtra and he could not appear before the trial Court. Learned counsel further submits that now the petitioner himself has surrendered on 26.08.2019 and since then, he is in custody.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer, has not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 26.08.2019; challan stands presented; the case also stands committed to the Court of Sessions and the same is fixed for recording the prosecution evidence, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
