The grievance of the petitioner is that the police authorities of the State of Punjab are not taking any action against the unofficial respondent on the strength of the complaint dated 10.06.2019 made by the petitioner to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar City, marking a copy thereof to the Station House Officer, Division No.7, Police Station, Jalandhar City.

However perusal of the complaint aforestated demonstrates that the petitioner did not cite any ingredients necessary to constitute a criminal offence whereby the police would have jurisdiction in the matter. On the other hand this Court finds that the petitioner directly asked for an injunction restraining the neighbours from preventing his entry into the house. Such relief cannot be sought from the police authorities, by any stretch of imagination. Having made such a complaint, it is not open to the petitioner to now complain of inaction, as the complaint itself was utterly misconceived. The writ petition is

accordingly dismissed on this short ground. However, it is made clear that this order shall not preclude the petitioner from making a complaint afresh with full particulars, in the event a criminal offence, is committed against him.
