On 31.10.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for pre-arrest bail in FIR No.156 dated 29.09.2019 registered under Sections 323/324/452/379/427/506/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that offence under Section 326 IPC has been added later on. He further submits that there is a delay of three days in lodging of the FIR and as per case of the prosecution, petitioner has caused injury to the first informant on little finger of the left hand. He also submits that petitioner has been falsely implicated because of being business competitor.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr.SPS Tinna, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab. A copy of the petition be handed over to him during the course of the day.

List on 22.11.2019.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However,

the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, has submitted that petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 31.10.2019 is made absolute.
