On 08.01.2019, this Court passed the following order:-

“The present appeal is arising out of judgment and decree of the Courts below whereby suit for recovery of Rs.3,50,000/- along with interest has been confined to Rs.15,000/-. As per provisions of Section 102 C.P.C., appeal against the decree less than Rs.25,000/- is not maintainable.

Mr. Saggar seeks short accommodation to apprise this Court regarding maintainability of the appeal.

Adjourned to 01.03.2019.

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the appellant, has not been able to apprise this Court regarding maintainability of the appeal. The appeal against the decree below less Rs. 25,000/- is not maintainable as per provisions of Section 102 CPC.
