On 31.10.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.297 dated 18.8.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Phillaur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon order dated 7.10.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-42999-2019 while dealing with the case of co-accused. He further submits that the amount of Rs.3,80,000/- stands paid.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. S.P.S.Tinna, Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 15.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as

provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 31.10.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
