On 01.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 23.08.2019 registered under Sections 324/341/506/34/326 (added later on) of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that injury No.3 which is only injury declared grievous in nature, is attributed to have been caused by the brother of the petitioner. He further submits that brother of the petitioner had also suffered injury and, therefore, it is a case of version and cross version.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Surinder Pal Singh Tinna, Additional A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions. Adjourned to 26.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satwinder

Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the

investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties have now mutually settled the dispute.

In view thereof, interim order dated 01.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
