Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.80 dated 13.08.2019 under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 04.11.2019: -

“...It is stated in the petition that the petitioner had purchased the land from co-accused Jasbir Singh and Sarabjit Singh, after verifying the sale deed and had further sold to co-accused Piar Kaur. It is further stated that Piar Kaur and Jasbir Singh have already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 04.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-42589-2019...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jarnail Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 04.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
