Despite the case having been called twice, the appellants have gone un-represented.

Perusal of the file shows that after filing of this appeal in January 2017, the same has been taken on Board for five times including today. Every time, appellant has gone un-represented.

A written request for adjournment has been circulated by learned counsel for the appellants on the ground that he is out of station, due to some personal difficulty.

The above request for adjournment cannot be entertained, in view of judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court dated 07.02.2019, passed in Civil Appeals No. 9142-9144-2010 and Civil Appeal No. 6156 of 2012, titled as 'Ram Siromani Tripathi and others Vs. State of U.P. and others'. Hence, the request for adjournment is rejected.

In view of the above factual position, it can safely be

presumed that neither the appellants nor their counsel are interested in pursuing the instant appeal.

Consequently, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution. In case, any application for restoration of the appeal is moved, the same shall be allowed, subject to payment of requisite costs.
