Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to get the investigation of the FIR No.48 dated 06.08.2018 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, from some senior police official.

On 02.11.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, DAG, Punjab is directed to find out the status of investigation in FIR No.48 dated 06.08.2018 under Section 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply requisite sets of paper book to the learned State counsel, during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 04.12.2019.”

Learned State counsel has filed Status report by way of an affidavit of Ashwini Gotyal IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police City-I, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3-State, wherein it is mentioned that the cancellation report under Section 173 Cr.P.C is likely to be submitted before the competent Court of jurisdiction within four weeks.

At this stage, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the petition is rendered infructuous.
