Prayer in the petition is to transfer the investigation of a complaint made to police.

Reply has been filed on behalf of the respondents wherein it has been stated that the enquiry has already been conducted by the Superintendent of Police, Khanna during the pendency of the present petition.

Dispute is with regard to possession of a small piece of land. It is being claimed that because of the police pressure, husband of the petitioner had set himself on fire and allegedly received 40% burn injuries but survived.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to pass any order while exercising its powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to avail remedy before the Magistrate.
