Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.301 dated 24.08.2019 under Section 15 of NDPS Act (Section 47-A of NDPS Act was added during the investigation), registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 01.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police apprehended co-accused Surajbhan @ Surjan and recovered 37 kg of poppy husk. It is further submitted that name of the petitioner surfaced later, on the basis of disclosure statement of aforesaid co-accused Surajbhan

@ Surjan and the petitioner is not involved in any other case...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Mahavir Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 01.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
