The claim in the present writ petition is to pay interest amount on annuity, which has allegedly been received by the petitioners belatedly. The representation filed by the petitioners or the writ petition does not quantify the amounts received and the delay period.

In such circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that no direction can be issued in the absence of complete particulars.

Faced with this hurdle, counsel for the petitioners submits that detailed representation will be filed and thereafter he may be permitted to adjudicate afresh for his cause.

Accordingly writ petition is dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.
