Counsel for the respondents would state that execution filed by the respondents already stands satisfied.

On the last date of hearing, order of status quo was vacated as counsel for the appellant failed to make submissions, despite directions vide order dated 27.02.2019 that the case would be taken up immediately after incomplete cases.

A relevant extract from order dated 11.04.2019, reads as follows:

Counsel for the appellant is not present for making submissions. A request for passover is made at 2.50 pm, despite the fact that the case was ordered to be taken up immediately after incomplete cases. Perusal of the records would reveal that there was no appearance on behalf of the appellant on 26.10.2018 and 27.02.2019. It appears that since there is an order of status quo with regard to possession, the Court proceedings are being taken for granted. The order of status quo dated 19.07.2018 stands vacated. Necessary intimation be sent to the quarter(s) concerned.

There is no representation on behalf of the appellant.

Dismissed for non prosecution.
