Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.109 dated 12.9.2019 registered under Sections 380, 457, 411 IPC at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith her husband and other co-accused have stolen Rs. 1 lac cash and 380 grams of gold jewellery.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Manjit Bharti has submitted that 310 gram of jewellery and Rs.70,000/- has been recovered from the petitioner. He further informs the Court that co-accused i.e husband of the petitioner is absconding and proceedings for declaring him proclaimed offender have been initiated. Final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C has been filed on conclusion of the investigation against the petitioner and the case is now fixed for

recording of prosecution witnesses.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant bail.

Dismissed.
