Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.243 dated 13.09.2019 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, though the police has received a secret information, however, the petitioner was neither arrested at the spot nor the alleged recovery was effected from her. It is further submitted that the petitioner is a lady and is not involved in any other case and the recovery is of non-commercial quantity...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
