The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that she is entitled for the pension @ ₹10350/- per month, whereas she is being paid the basic pension of ₹9941/- per month.

The petitioner has averred in the writ petition that her pension cannot be less than 50% of the minimum of the pay scale + grade pay but she is being paid less pension than her entitlement.

From the pleadings, it transpires that for the relief, which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted a representation dated 27.03.2019 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 27.03.2019 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of next three months.
