The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 201 dated 03.08.2019, under Sections 195, 196, 197, 198, 420, 467, 468, 471, 494, 497, 506 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged in the FIR that co-accused Manjit had solemnized his marriage with Anju although Anju was already married to the complainant. It is alleged that the petitioners had connived with co-accused Manjit in solemnizing his marriage with the wife of the complainant.

This Court, by the order dated 02.11.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ved Pal, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 02.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
