Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No.706 dated 17.11.2018 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Quilla, District Panipat.

As per the case of the prosecution, first informant has been cheated of Rs.6 lacs by accused Jai Kumar, Dheeraj, Nitin and Pankaj on a false assurance of securing a job for his son. As per the allegations, Dheeraj has sent a false joining letter of his sister on the whatsapp messenger of the complainant to gain his confidence and later on he had also sent a joining report of son of the complainant in July, 2017 on whatsapp. The aforesaid joining letter was found to be forged.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that subsequently there was settlement between the parties and first informant had agreed to receive Rs. 6 lacs towards full and final settlement. For discharging that liability, 6 cheques of Rs. 1 lac each signed by Dheeraj were supplied which

were dishonoured.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner being brother of Dheeraj has been falsely implicated. He further points out that Jai Kumar, father of the petitioner and Dheeraj has already been granted bail.

Investigations are complete. The case is triable by Magistrate. Police report has been filed. Conclusion of the trial is likely to take time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, present petition stands allowed.
