Learned State counsel on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that pursuant to the order of this court dated 01.11.2019, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required presently.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the order dated 01.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his legal remedy as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.
