On 16.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.69 dated 12.5.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 148, 149, 506 IPC and Section 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act (added lateron) at Police Station Dugri, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in the connected case ie. CRM-M-36845-2019, this Court had granted interim protection. He further submits that the injury which has been attributed to have been caused by the petitioner has been declared simple and not grievous by the medical board constituted.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra,

Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice

on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 4.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 16.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
