AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The petitioner filed a writ petition in which one of the prayer was for quashing of appellate order dated 17.10.2014 whereby the appeal of the petitioner for grant of full terminal/retiral benefits alongwith interest w.e.f. due date i.e. 02.11.2001 was rejected. The writ petition was allowed on 05.05.2017, the impugned orders were set aside. The amount of ₹1,04,955.57/- recovered from the petitioner was ordered to be refunded alongwith interest @ 9% per annum alongwith remaining arrears on which interest @ 9% was to be given from three months from the date of his resignation till date of the payment. The contempt petition is filed pleading that

needful is not done by the respondents.

Reply filed today in the Court, is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that refund of ₹1,04,955.57/- alongwith interest @ 9% per annum and payment of remaining arrears alongwith interest @ 9% per annum has been made.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that interest has not been properly calculated.

There is no wilful disobedience of directions of this Court, rather there is substantial compliance.

The contempt petition is dismissed.

However, petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievance, including challenge to calculation of interest.
