Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.20 dated 06.04.2019 registered under Sections 302/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although petitioner is armed with *daatar*, however, no injury is attributed to have been caused by the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 12.04.2019 for a period of more than 7 months.

Investigations are complete. Police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed. Prosecution has started recording his evidence. As per the information supplied by the State counsel, petitioner is not involved

in any other case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
