On 04.11.2019, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No. 61 dated 22.9.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 326, 405, 34 IPC at Police Station Kahnuwan, District Gurdaspur.

It has been pleaded that there is delay of more than a month in registration of the FIR. Petitioner also suffered injury in the aforesaid scuffle and the injury which the petitioner is alleged to have caused is on non-vital part of the body. Reliance is also placed on interim protection granted by this Court in case of co-accused vide order dated 17.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-43882-2019.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Baljit Mann, an employee from the office of Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab.

List alongwith CRM-M-43882-2019 on 16.11.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raman Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 04.11.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
