Since common questions of law and facts are involved in these
appeals, therefore, these are taken up together and being disposed of by a

common judgment.

These Letters Patent Appeals are instituted against the judgment dated 17.09.2019 rendered by the learned Single Judge in CWP-8953-2019 and analogous matters.

The minimum essential eligibility qualification for filling up the posts was diploma/degree. The appellants are holding ITI/CTI certificates. The fact of the matter is that for contractual appointment, the candidates were required to be diploma/degree holders. The appellants, who do not possess minimum essential eligibility qualification, could not be appointed against the post meant for holders of diploma/degree.

Accordingly, there is no merit in the appeals and the same are dismissed.
