Prayer in the application is to transfer the civil suit filed by brother-in-law for grant of damages on account of loss of reputation and other things filed against his sister-in-law and her family members.

It has been pointed out that the suit stems out of the matrimonial discord between defendant No.1 and her husband. The plaintiff is brother of the husband. It is undisputed that another litigation between the parties is pending at Yamuna Nagar.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the application is allowed. The suit titled as 'Ravinderpal Singh Vs. Guneet Kaur and others' is transferred from the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ludhiana to the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Yamuna Nagar who can either try the suit itself or transfer the suit to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Yamuna Nagar.

The Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Ludhiana is directed to remit the record of the

case to the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Yamuna Nagar within 15 days.

Parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Yamuna Nagar on 11.04.2019.

Transfer Application is disposed of.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
