By way of filing the present application, applicant Shikha wife of Lovdish Dhawan-respondent, presently residing with her parents at Sri Muktsar Sahib seeks transfer of divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 filed by her husband Lovdish Dhawan against her having title 'Lovdish Dhawan Vs. Shikha' pending in the Court of Sh.Sanjay Agnihotri, Additional District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Notice of the application was given to the respondent, who put in appearance through counsel and had filed reply opposing the application. But today, learned counsel for the respondent has made a statement at the Bar that he does not oppose the application and he has no objection if divorce petition is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Accordingly, the application in hand is accepted, the same is allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of Sh. Sanjay Agnihotri, Additional District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali and transferred to the Court of District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib for disposal in accordance with law. Learned District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib may retain the petition on his board or assign it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear in the transferee Court on 11.2.2019. Copies of orders be sent to the Court of Sh. Sanjay Agnihotri, Additional District Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali as well as to the Court of District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib for information and necessary compliance.
