The contempt petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 20.02.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No.7570 of 2019 whereby directions were issued to the Superintendent of Police to dispose of complaint dated 31.01.2019 within a period of three months.

Today, reply by way of affidavit dated 13/16.12.2019 of Superintendent of Police, Hansi annexing order dated 09.12.2019 is filed in the Court, same is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of order dated 09.12.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing
