The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.233 dated 14.12.2002, under Sections 326, 324 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of 02 days in registering the FIR. The petitioner was in custody and later granted regular bail on 24.01.2003. He thereafter had gone abroad and was under the impression that the matter has been settled since the similarly situated co-accused namely Varun Kumar was acquitted by the trial Court on 16.12.2009. In the absence of the petitioner, he had been declared as a proclaimed offender. He also contends that the petitioner is willing to surrender before the trial Court and prefer an application for regular bail and the trial Court may be directed to decide the same on the same day. He, therefore, does not press this petition to enable the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of as not pressed.

In the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided in accordance with law expeditiously in view of the aforementioned submissions of the counsel for the petitioner.
