By way of this writ petition, the petitioner seeks correction of entries in his passport in relation to his mother's name; the name of his village; and his date of birth. It is his case that he submitted necessary documents in support of corrections sought by him but requisite action is not being taken by the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh, to effect the said corrections and issue him a new passport with proper entries.

Ms. Shweta Nahata, learned counsel for the Union of India and the Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh, would inform this Court that the matter is under examination and upon verification of the claims put-forth by the petitioner in relation to the corrections sought by him, appropriate action would be taken. She would further state that the needful would be done

within one month from today. In that view of the matter, no further

adjudication is called for in this case.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of directing the respondents and more particularly, the Regional Passport Officer, Chandigarh, the second respondent, to take appropriate action upon the petitioner's request for effecting corrections in his passport expeditiously and in any event, not later than one month from today. In the event the request of the petitioner is turned down for any reason, the same shall be informed to him by way of a detailed order.
