Applicant Sureshta wife of respondent Rajesh Kumar has filed the instant application, seeking transfer of divorce petition, filed by her husband, the respondent against her having title 'Rajesh Kumar Vs. Sureshta' pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Gurdaspur to any other Court of competent jurisdiction outside District Gurdaspur for the reason that the respondent is working as an Addl. Ahlmad in the Court of Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.) Gurdaspur, as such, can influence the judicial proceedings.

The application is being opposed by the respondent vehemently.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties besides going through the record and I find that there is no reason to accept the present application. A lowly placed official like an Ahlmad working in a Court cannot dare to interfere in judicial proceedings. The apprehension

expressed by the applicant that he may do so, using his connection with the staff and by approaching the Presiding Officer, are unfounded and without any basis. Both the parties are residents of District Gurdaspur and the divorce petition is pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Gurdaspur. I do not see any reason to accept the application and direct transfer of the divorce petition to any other Court situated outside Gurdaspur District. Therefore, the application stands dismissed.
