Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.3 dated 06.01.2014 registered under Sections 307, 332, 353, 186, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala.

Petitioner was granted the concession of bail. However, he jumped bail on 03.06.2016. Thereafter, he was declared Proclaimed Offender on 12.08.2016.

As per the information supplied by the learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Jeet Singh, petitioner is "A-Category gangster" involved in large number of cases of robbery, snatching, dacoity, murder. He further submits that case under Section 52-A of the Prisons Act has also

been registered against the petitioner because he attacked Deputy Superintendent of Jail.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the murder trial, petitioner has been acquitted.

Be that as it may. As per the list supplied, as many as 8 cases including the present one are pending against him.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody, learned trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously.
