Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 34 dated 14.04.2017 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda, Punjab.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner was not apprehended at the spot. Even the version of the prosecution regarding involving of the car is questionable.

The custody certificate tendered by the learned State counsel in Court today, is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has already undergone 4 months 4 days.
