Learned counsel appearing for the applicants submits that the only purpose for the applicants moving this application for transfer was that conflicting decisions by the two Courts should be avoided and applicants are prepared to get their petition bearing No.5 of 2017, having title Haryana State Warehousing Corporation and another Vs. M/s Aggerwal Rice Mills and another, petition No.6 of 2017 having title Haryana State Warehousing Corporation and another Vs. M/s Radha Rice Mills and another and petition No.7 of 2017 having title Haryana State Warehousing Corporation and another Vs. M/s Shiv Shakti International and another, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Ambala, transferred to the Court of Addl. District Judge, Panchkula, where the connected matters are pending.

Learned counsel representing the respondent states that he has no objection, if it is so done.

Accordingly, it is directed that petition Nos.5, 6 & 7 of 2017 having title as mentioned above, pending in the Court of Addl. District Judge, Ambala are withdrawn from that Court and are transferred to the Court of Addl. District Judge, Panchkula, where the connected matter bearing Nos.21, 22 and 23 of 2017 are pending for their disposal in accordance with law. This order has been passed by mutual consent of both the counsel, in the interest of justice to avoid contradictory decisions.

The parties through counsel are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 26.03.2019, the date stated to be fixed in the

connected matters. Copies of orders be given to learned counsel for the parties under signatures of Bench Secretary to enable them to pursue the matter properly.
