Petitioners filed a writ petition for quashing of order dated 15.04.2019, 31.04.2019 and 04.04.2019 vide which the pension of the petitioners was reduced in pursuance to certain recovery. Notice of motion was issued on 15.05.2019 and till the next date, the respondents were restrained from reducing pension of the petitioner.

The present petition is filed pleading wilful disobedience of directions of this Court.

Learned counsel for the State has filed replies on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 2, same is taken on record, copy supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State relying upon the pleadings of the reply, submits that the pension was reduced prior to passing of the interim order, however, the same was restored after receiving the copy of the order of this Court. He submits that directions were issued to the Treasury Officer

vide memo No.Pen-2/CWP-127887-2019/4246-47 dated 13.12.2019 to implement the interim order. It is further submitted that vide letter No.507, dated 16.12.2019 the Treasury Officer had informed that the pension has been restored.

The contention of learned counsel for the State are not contradicted by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, contempt petition is disposed of.
