The matter has been settled between the parties as per report received from the Mediation Centre in the connected matter. In terms of the settlement, the parties have agreed to get their marriage dissolved by decree of divorce by mutual consent. It being so, no cause of action survives to the applicant and therefore, the present application seeking transfer of divorce petition pending before District Judge, Family Court, Ambala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ludhiana has become infructuous and is dismissed accordingly. However, it is observed that in case, the respondent resiles from the settlement and does not withdraw the petition in question, then the applicant shall have a right to approach this Court again, seeking transfer of the petition in question.
