Applicant Parveen Kumari, aged 30 years presently residing with her parents at Nangal, District Rupnagar on account of a matrimonial discord with her husband Vijay Kumar, the respondent, by way of filing the present application is seeking transfer of divorce petition filed by her husband Vijay Kumar against her having title 'Vijay Kumar Vs. Parveen Kumari' pending before Addl. District Judge, Hoshiarpur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Rupnagar.

According to the applicant, the parties got married on 08.10.2016 at Hoshiarpur. Thereafter, they started residing together at VPO Nangal Bihala, Tehsil Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur. The applicant gave birth to a female child from the loins of respondent who is presently aged about 11 years. On account of differences arisen between the spouses, the applicant had to leave the matrimonial home. The applicant does not have any source of income. She is taking care of minor daughter

of the parties. It is difficult for her to travel from Nangal to Hoshiarpur to attend the dates of hearing in Court covering a distance of about 70 kms on one side. As such, the application be accepted.

Notice of the application was given to the respondent, who as per office report has been duly served through his brother but has not turned up to contest the application.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record and I find sufficient reasons to accept the application. Accordingly, the same is allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of Addl. District Judge, Hoshiarpur and transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Rupnagar for disposal in accordance with law. Learned District Judge, Rupnagar may retain the petition on his board or assign it to any other Court of competent jurisdiction.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear in the transferee Court on 06.03.2019. Copies of orders be sent to both the Courts for information and necessary compliance.
