By this order, two petitions bearing CRM-M-46987-2019 and
CRM-M-47656-2019 shall stand disposed of.

Prayer is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in FIR
No.34 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 170, 171, 294, 323, 365,
420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Khui Khera, District

Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the State, was requested to get complete information and assist.

As per case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith co-accused had duped the first informant of his hard earned money on the pretext that the petitioner and his co-accused shall double the amounts while taking benefit of their illiteracy and exploiting their religious leaning.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Mukhtiar Singh, has submitted that the petitioner Lakhvir Singh @ Lakhi in CRM-M-46987-2019 is a previous convict under Section 420 IPC. Yet another FIR is also pending against him.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, both the petitions are dismissed.
