Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.100, dated 06.11.2017, registered under Sections 302/34 IPC, at Police Station Rori, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Umed Singh, has submitted that the prosecution has already got recorded depositions of 14 witnesses out of 19 proposed to be examined. He further submits that today is the date before the trial Court for recording evidence of all the remaining witnesses.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this court is not inclined to consider the prayer for grant of bail, at this stage, particularly when conclusion of the trial is in sight.

The present petition is disposed of with direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial positively within 2 months.
