Prayer in the writ petition is for issuing direction to respondents to consider the petitioner eligible for promotion to the post of TGT (English) w.e.f. 25.07.2018 as claim of petitioner for promotion has wrongly been rejected orally on the ground that petitioner is not having 50% marks in B.A whereas there is no such requirement for candidates having qualification of BA/B.Sc/B.Com with 2 years diploma in elementary education.

As per averments in writ petition, petitioner has already made a legal notice dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken so far.

Without going into the merits and demerits of the claim of the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to direct respondent No.2-Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, Shiksha Sadan, Sector 5, Panchkula to consider the legal notice dated 30.09.2019 (Annexure P-5) within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and pass a speaking order thereon, failing which respondent No.2 shall be liable

to pay costs of ₹25,000/- to the petitioner. This condition of imposing costs is only to prevent petitioner running from pillar to post and avail remedy of contempt in case of non-compliance of directions issued by this Court.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above direction.
