The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks directions to the District Judge, Nawashahr to adjudicate the claim of the parties expeditiously, keeping in view the fact that on an earlier occasion the directions had been issued by this Court in **CWP No.13700 of 2018 'Dilabg Singh Vs. Union of India and others'** decided on 28.05.2018 (Annexure P-10) to decide the matters expeditiously within a period of six months from the receipt of the certified copy of the order.

In pursuance of the last order dated 21.11.2019, counsel has placed on record photocopy of the zimni orders passed by the Additional District Judge, Nawashahr in **LAC-1-18 'Sucha Singh Vs. Dilabgh Singh.**

A perusal of the said zimni orders would go on to show that counsel for the petitioner-Sucha Singh who is arrayed as respondent No.4 herein, had been taking adjournments at the asking and not addressing arguments. Resultantly, the directions issued by this Court are not being complied with. This would be clear from the perusal of the order dated 17.10.2019, 30.10.2019 and 05.11.2019.

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Counsel has now pointed out that the matter is now fixed for
06.12.2019.

Keeping in view the above, it is expected that the Reference
Court shall ensure that the matter be decided within a period one month
from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed off, accordingly.
