Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.206, dated 25.06.2019, registered under Sections 379/328/420/34 IPC, at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner along with co-accused had snatched ATM card along with Rs.5000/- and thereafter misused the aforesaid ATM card and withdrew Rs.12000/- plus Rs.100/-.

It is undisputed that co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted concession of regular bail by the court of Sessions. Petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2019. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the first informant-victim has not supported the case of the prosecution.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 25.06.2019 and conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of

adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
