This criminal writ petition has been filed under Section 226 Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus for releasing detainee Muskan Bhandari (daughter of the petitioner) from the illegal custody of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that this Court had entertained the writ petition filed by the alleged detainee along with her husband seeking protection as they apprehended threat from the private respondents in the writ petition (including the present petitioner). It is also not disputed by learned counsel that the petitioner has not filed any representation before the SSP, where the writ petitioners were relegated to pursue their relief.

In view of above, no ground is made out for invoking the extra ordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 Constitution of India.

The petition is dismissed.
