Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.263 dated 31.08.2018 under Sections 420, 506 IPC, Section 24 of Immigration Act and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.11.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, primarily allegations are against one Joginder Singh, to whom the money was paid...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the

aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shish Pal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.11.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
