This revision petition was filed by Mr.Tarun Dhingra, Advocate. Case was listed on 4.11.2019 at Sr.No.112. None appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the date fixed, still this Court passed the following order:-

“In the interest of justice, adjourned to 29.11.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall satisfy this Court as to how revision petition is maintainable against the order vide which 3rd party objections were dismissed by the Executing Court.”

Today also despite three pass overs since morning, none has come to attend this Court.

I have gone through the impugned order.

Petitioner has made challenge to the order dated 30.8.2019 passed by the Executing Court vide which third party objections filed by the petitioner were dismissed. The dismissal of third party objections would form a decree in terms of Order 21 Rule 103 CPC and the same would be appealable. Precisely, this observation was made by this Court on 4.11.2019 requiring learned counsel for the petitioner to satisfy this Court as to how the revision petition is maintainable against dismissal of third party objections. It appears that learned counsel for the petitioner has lost track of the case and is not interested in pursuing this case.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
