This is application No.3 filed for grant of bail to the petitioner in a criminal case arising from FIR No.154 dated 07.11.2017 registered under Sections 21, 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Division No.2, Jalandhar.

On 10.05.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, as the petitioner is in custody since 07.11.2017, trial Court is directed to expedite the trial by giving short adjournments.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that still the trial of the case is not over. He submits that the case is getting adjourned for one reason or the other.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, learned Presiding Judge of the Special Court is requested to conclude the trial of the case within 3 months positively even if he has to take up the case on day to day basis.

Disposed of, accordingly.
