Applicant Lalita Singh, aged about 33 years wife of respondent Sunil Chauhan, by way of moving the present application is seeking transfer of divorce petition filed by her husband, the respondent against her having title 'Sunil Chauhan Vs. Lalita' pending in the Court of Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bhiwani.

According to the applicant, marriage between the parties did not work properly and she had to leave the matrimonial home returning to her parental house. Her husband has filed the petition in question just to harass her. It is stated that the applicant is working as a lecturer posted at Ambala and is taking care of a minor daughter of the parties who is residing with the applicant and is studying in a school at Ambala. It is

difficult for her to travel from Ambala to Rohtak covering a distance of about 100 kms on one side. Her husband had filed a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act against her and on an application having been filed by her, the same was transferred to the Court at Bhiwani, therefore, the present application be accepted.

Notice of the application was given to the respondent, who as per office report is duly served but has not put in appearance.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant besides going through the record.

Keeping in view the contentions in the application and submissions made by learned counsel for the applicant, I find sufficient reasons to accept the application. Accordingly, the same is accordingly allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak and transferred to Family Court at Bhiwani for disposal in accordance with law.

The parties through their counsel are directed to appear in the transferee Court on 06.03.2019. Copies of orders be sent to both the Courts for information and necessary compliance.
