Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that vide order dated 06.06.2013 (Annexure P-7), the Gram Panchayat-respondent No.4 has been declared to be the owner of the property in dispute, which is stated to be in possession of the petitioner. Thereafter, the Gram Panchayat filed a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act 1961, which has been allowed by DDPO on the ground that the Panchayat has been declared to be the owner in a petition under Section 11 filed by the private person and the petitioner could not establish his status on the land in dispute, much less, the permissible possession.

In view of the above discussion, we hardly find any ground for

interference by this Court.

Hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
