1. Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to correct father's name of the petitioner to read as 'Jugmail Singh' instead of 'Bikkar Singh' in the Detailed Marks Certificate of ANM 1st and 2nd Year (Annexure P-2) as per Matriculation Certificate of the petitioner Annexure P-1 dated 2.6.2009 and in view of written request of respondent No.3 to respondent No.2.

2. Having considered the matter, I am of the view that the writ petition can be disposed of without issuing notice of motion by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-3 and P-4 dated 26.07.2016 and 07.03.2017 respectively claimed to have been written by respondent No.3 to respondent No.2.

3. In the circumstances, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to treat the writ petition as a representation and to consider and decide the prayer made by the petitioner in the light of representation Annexures P-3 and P-4 dated 26.07.2016 and 07.03.2017

respectively within four weeks from the date of supply of certified copy of this order besides copy of the writ petition alongwith Annexures.
